 SECTION 3: Alton Campus Bus Pass Application – If you require a College bus pass which will enable you enable you to travel to and from the Alton Campus on Stagecoach bus, please complete the section below: -

Bus passes must be downloaded on the student's phone via the Stagecoach website / app. Students will need to scan the pass on their phone each time they use the bus. All passes must be used with the student's College ID card (which will be provided on enrolment days for new students). In some circumstances it may be possible for the student to have a plastic ticket, but this may incur a fee which is charged by the bus company.

1) ANNUAL PASSES - This pass will enable you to travel from home to the Alton Campus; these passes are annual (1 Sep 2026 – 31 Aug 2027), and can also be used at weekends, half terms, Christmas and Easter Holidays and must be used with a college ID card at all times.

South Western Railway are offering full-time Alton College students discounted train passes for the below train stations.
