

Havant Campus Bus Passes:

You may find this guide useful when deciding which bus pass you need to travel from your home address to the Havant Campus.

Please locate the student's home postcode in the table below; the bus pass needed is next to the postcode - this is the pass that is necessary to enable you to travel from where you live to the Havant Campus (for an extra cost, you can also choose to upgrade your bus pass to use it other areas). There is also a bus pass guide on the reverse, so you can see what areas each bus pass can be used in.

There is some important information to note if you live in the following areas:

PO1-PO6: Some students living in **Paulsgrove** or **Eastney** may also require the use of a First Bus pass (in addition to a Stagecoach South Hants pass). Please contact us if you think this may apply to you.

PO12-PO17: First Bus services from this area travelling to the Havant Campus, are very limited. **Gosport/Fareham/Portchester** students can board the **college SD5 bus** and **Bishops Waltham/Swanmore/Wickham** students can board the **college SD4 bus** - both services travel directly to the Havant Campus with one service in the morning and one service back at the end of the college day.

SO30-SO32 & SO40: Bus services travelling to the Havant Campus from this area are extremely limited & you may wish to travel by train.

Bus Passes available for the Havant Campus and the areas they can be used in

First Bus Student Hants (All Zones) (Valid from 1 Sept – 31 July 2027)	Waterlooville, Clanfield, Horndean, Lovedean, Cowplain, Purbrook, Cosham, Portsmouth, Bishop's Waltham, Swanmore, Waltham Chase, Shedfield, Wickham Square, Gosport, Fareham, Portchester, Paulsgrove, Titchfield, Whiteley, Warsash, Locks Heath, Hedge End, Southampton (except the motorway service). If using the SD5-bus service from Gosport/Fareham/Portchester or the SD4-bus service from Bishops Waltham/Wickham you may travel as far as the Havant Campus but no further into Havant. ** This pass covers travel to the South Downs Campus (and only the Havant Campus using the SD4/SD5 bus services) **
Stagecoach Havant StudentRider (Valid from 1 Sept – 31 Aug 2027)	Rectory Avenue, Bedhampton, Havant, West Leigh, Leigh Park & as far as South Downs Campus ** This pass covers travel to both Havant & South Downs Campuses **
Stagecoach South Hants StudentRider (Valid from 1 Sept – 31 Aug 2027)	Havant Road, Rectory Avenue, Bedhampton, Havant, West Leigh, Leigh Park, Waterlooville, Hambledon, Denmead, Clanfield, Horndean, Lovedean, Cowplain, Purbrook, Portsmouth, Hayling Island, Emsworth (as far as Emsworth Square). ** This pass covers travel to both Havant & South Downs Campuses **
Stagecoach Gold StudentRider (Valid from 1 Sept – 31 Aug 2027)	Havant Road, Rectory Avenue, Bedhampton, Havant, West Leigh, Leigh Park, Waterlooville, Hambledon, Denmead, Clanfield, Horndean, Lovedean, Cowplain, Purbrook, Portsmouth, Hayling Island, Emsworth, Chichester, Petersfield, Liss and Bordon. This ticket can also be used within Hampshire, Surrey, West Sussex, Wiltshire & Brighton. ** This pass covers travel to both Havant & South Downs Campuses **
