SUBSIDY PAYMENTS: All College Travel Subsidies are a one-off payment, regardless of whether an Annual or Termly bus pass is purchased. Stagecoach will send an email to the Stagecoach app. account holder in January. Under Data Protection a reply is required for Stagecoach to then be able to pass on the bus pass purchased information to the college. Once this is received HSDC will send an email late February to request bank details and the subsidy will be paid during April. Without this confirmation from Stagecoach, we will be unaware of the purchase made and won't process the subsidy automatically. Students must be still enrolled on their course to receive the subsidy.

- The pass listed against the student's home postcode in the tables above, is the pass you need to travel from home to college. When you purchase the bus pass online, you may decide to upgrade the pass so you can use it to travel further afield (useful if you need to travel to another area for a part-time job for example). If you decide to upgrade the pass, the subsidy amount you are entitled to (if applicable), will remain the same as the subsidy amount shown against the home postcode.
- All bus passes can be used at **weekends** and in the **evenings** within the allowed area and must be used with a student ID card – they should not be used out of date or out of zone, otherwise your pass may be confiscated or withdrawn.
- The service routes on this form, are only **suggested** routes to get students from their home to the Havant Campus. Other routes can be used within the allowed zones for the chosen bus pass.
- No bus services are guaranteed, and most services are not run under contract to HSDC. Therefore, some bus services/routes may be updated or changed over the summer, please go to the First Bus or Stagecoach websites for the latest travel and timetable information.
